The Role: The bilingual Psychologist provides direct clinical services to children, adolescents, and families and supports the supervision and training of doctoral students, including psychology interns matched through Momentous Institute's APA-Accredited Internship Program.

The position includes a combination of therapy, psychological assessment, clinical supervision, professional training, and program development. Responsibilities also include supporting bilingual clinical services and training, collaborating with Momentous Institute and Momentous School staff and community partners, contributing to professional development and training activities, and participating in program evaluation and continuous improvement efforts.

Professional Responsibilities

Your time will be divided between direct clinical care, supervision, and professional training.

- Provide evidence-based individual, family, and group therapy to children, adolescents and adult caregivers.
- Conduct comprehensive psychological assessments, including evaluations for learning, autism, emotional, and behavioral concerns. Some assessments will engage bilingual clients and therefore, will require administration of measurements in Spanish.
- Supervise the clinical and administrative work of psychology trainees, including supervision of both therapy and assessment. This includes supervision of services provided in Spanish. Supervision meetings may also take place in Spanish to assist trainees with the development of clinical language.
- Attend planning meetings to contribute to the implementation and development of training programs at Momentous Institute.

- Collaborate with training committee members and Momentous Institute staff as needed to support the development of trainees.
- Provide trainings (in the community and internally) on topics relevant to the field of child/family psychology.
- Help strengthen and expand bilingual psychology training within our APA-accredited doctoral training program.
- Partner with Momentous School and community organizations to support children across multiple settings.
- Design and deliver professional development for clinicians and community partners.
- Contribute to content shared through our blog, training videos and other public facing outlets.
- Contribute to program evaluation and innovation initiatives that improve outcomes for children and families.

Professional Qualifications

- Psychologist licensed or provisionally licensed in Texas. Provisionally licensed candidates must have passed the EPPP national examination to be considered.
- Doctoral degree from a psychology program accredited by the American Psychological Association (APA).
- Completion of a 2,000-hour APA-accredited doctoral internship.
- Bilingual in English and Spanish, with proficiency providing therapy services in Spanish.
- Experience supervising doctoral-level psychology trainees, including clinical and/or assessment supervision.
- Minimum of three years of experience providing therapy services, with experience working with children and families preferred.
- Recent experience conducting psychological assessments with children and adolescents, including the use of current measures to assess learning, emotional, behavioral, and social functioning.
- Experience assessing bilingual children in English and Spanish is preferred.
- Ability to work effectively with clients, trainees, colleagues, and community partners from diverse backgrounds and lived experiences.
- Ability to provide clinical services at least two evenings per week.
- Clinical approach that is strengths-based and trauma-informed.
- Ability to contribute to program development, evaluation, and continuous improvement.
- Collaborative and team-oriented approach to work.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Strong interpersonal and relationship-building skills.
- Strong organizational and administrative skills, including management of personal and trainee clinical documentation.
- Ability to receive feedback, engage in self-reflection, and incorporate feedback into professional practice.
